

ENABLE GRANT



Supporting SEC connected projects which work to enable life in all its fullness for children young people and families (John 10:10).

Criteria

As the Church in Society Committee is interested in supporting a wide range of diverse types of initiatives, there are no specifically described prescribed **types** of project that will be funded.

However, applications for funding should include the following criteria:

- Identify a real need in the community
- Describe the expected impact of the project on the lives of children, young people and families
- Be deliverable within the timescales identified
- Demonstrate engagement with the wider community
- Must have some connection to an SEC congregation or diocese

All applications should be made using the approved [Enable Grant Application Form](#).

Monitoring

On behalf of the Mission Board, the Church in Society Committee will evaluate the effectiveness and impact of its grants by requiring a report accounting for how the grant has been used.

Additionally, all of the grant holders will be invited to attend an annual meeting where the programme and its context are discussed in a forum where we can share and learn from one another – though this will be optional depending on availability and willingness of project leaders.

The Church in Society Committee may work with the projects and the SEC Communications team to share stories and learning through channels such as *Inspires Online*.
